General Sessions

International/Fellowship Lounge

To extend a warm welcome to all members of our Fellowship, an International/Fellowship Lounge will be available. The lounge may include OA literature written in various languages. We encourage non-English-speaking OA members to bring their own printed materials to display in the lounge. The lounge is open to all OA members. The Boutique will be available Friday, starting at 8:00 AM (0800) and run through Sunday at noon (1200). OA service bodies may display and sell articles with OA-related themes. Individual groups are responsible for securing their merchandise.

Lodging Information

The official hotel for OA's 2016 Convention is the Boston Marriott Copley Place located at 110 Huntington Avenue, Boston, MA USA. Reservations can be made by calling 1-877-901-2079 or log onto https://www.oa.org/world-service-events/world-service-convention/ for a link to hotel reservations. Please use group code **OA** when calling the hotel. (Note: The WSO is not responsible for making reservations.)

You must make reservations by August 12, 2016. Rates are available August 26 through September 5. Note: August 23-25 and September 6-8 can be booked at the contracted rate based on room availability.

Lodging Rates

Rates do not include taxes, currently at 14.45%. (*Note: Meals are not included in the lodging rate.*)

All occupancies: \$145 USD per night

This rate includes 1-4 people per room, per night. Mini refrigerators and complimentary Internet are included in all rooms.

Lodging Payment

Accommodations require a credit card to guarantee a room. If you do not have a credit card to hold your reservation, a deposit may be required. Please contact the Boston Marriott Copley Place for instructions.

Lodging Cancellation

Cancellations are required 24 hours before the arrival date. A first night's room cost will be charged if cancellation is not made before the 24-hour arrival date.

Ground Transportation

The Boston Marriott Copley Place is approximately 10 miles from Boston Logan International Airport (BOS).

MBTA: Boston's transit system offers public transportation from BOS to the Copley area and is an approximate 35-minute ride. Buses depart approximately every 20 minutes. Passes range from \$2.00 to \$5.00 per trip. Please consult the MBTA for specific pricing.

Taxi: BOS offers taxi service to the Boston Marriott Copley Place for approximately \$40 one way.

Parking

Parking is available at the Copley Place Garage. This garage is not owned by the hotel. There are several city parking lots in the area of the Boston Marriott Copley Place ranging from \$25 to \$40 per day.

Copley Place Garage: Parking is currently at \$38 daily (overnight stay). Valet parking is \$53 daily. Payment is due upon

leaving the hotel's parking garage if paying by the hour. Please check the Copley Place Garage for hourly rates. If you are a hotel guest, parking will be charged to your room.

(Sautéed kale with olive oil, boiled quinoa, potatoes to bind, garlic, shallots, salt/pepper)

- Brown rice Black beans
- Steamed seasonal vegetables
- Red pepper sauce (roasted red peppers in vegetable stock on side)

Fresh Sliced Seasonal Fruit (1 ½ cups without added sugar)
